## **MAKE SPECIAL NOTE:**

1. The August school calendar and menu have been posted on our website.
2. Morning Car Line:
  - a. When joining the morning line, please join the line at the end. Due to daily temperature checks, the line is longer than normal. We thank you for your patience.
  - b. Students should have their school bags in the car with them. No one is allowed to get things out of the trunk due to safety reasons.
  - c. It would also be very helpful if the students have their backpack handy and are ready to exit the vehicle when you pull up for screening.
  - d. We kindly ask that you lower your passenger side window when you pull up to carline so that we can quickly ask the screening questions and check temperature.
3. Our class meetings will be virtual this year. Please check the school calendar for the dates and times. We are looking forward to seeing all of you.
4. Our Handbook of Policies was posted this summer. Please review the handbook and print page 42 which is the contract that must be signed by the students and both parents. The due date to turn in the signed contract is August 28, 2020.
5. Every vehicle in the car pick-up line for dismissal and after bell must have a dashboard sign with the name, grade, section, and class number of the child(ren) who are to leave school in that vehicle (ex. John Adams 4B #2). Please use large, dark lettering on your sign. If someone else occasionally picks up your child, please make sure that they have a sign.
6. If a child has to be picked up before the school day ends, a note should be sent with that child in the morning and approved by an administrator. Children should not be checked out after 3:15 PM. Calls to school to inform children of alternative arrangements for pick-up should be limited to emergencies.
7. We ask that you make any appointments for your child after school or near the end of the day. Our goal is to prevent our students from being exposed to germs from others that may be obtained at a doctor's office.
8. If your child is eating lunch from the cafeteria, it is important that he/she has money in their lunch account. Please contact Ms. Tiffany, our cafeteria manager, with any questions (985)-447-7756.
9. We will begin having school masses next Friday at 9:00 AM. At this time, only three grades will be attending mass in church and the rest of the school will participate through Zoom. Due to the current COVID restrictions, no visitors are allowed to attend School Mass in person. We ask that you join us in celebrating school masses live on Facebook. Thank you for your understanding!!
