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- Parents please do not cut the car line coming off of Alma Street onto Kenney Street at the 4 way stop sign.
- A clarification on returning to school after fever:
If a child has fever but no other systems, the child is free to come back to school after 24 hours fever free with no fever-reducing medication. In this case, the siblings can come to school. However, if a child has fever with one or more other symptoms, siblings will remain home as well. If a child begins running fever at school with one or more other symptoms, siblings will be sent home with the sick child.
- Please note that all communication from parents to teachers should be sent to school as a note and should not be sent via email. The only time email communication is permitted from parents to teachers is during distance learning.
