1. Our second May Crowning will be on Monday. It will be available on the school's website and Facebook page.
2. The last day of school for children in Pre-K and kindergarten is Tuesday, May 12th. Parents will be emailed the link to see the closing video. We invite all of you to a drive by on May 12, 2020 at 5:30 PM to wave good bye to the teachers and receive your report cards. It will follow the afternoon carline. Please do not exit your car and practice social distancing.
3. We will have work/textbook drop off days the last week of school.
 - a. We will follow the same procedure as the last drop off day. Cars will follow the afternoon carline route. Please do not exit your car and practice social distancing.
 - b. You will receive an individual checklist from your child's teacher containing what textbooks need to be returned. Please include this completed checklist with your child's name and grade/section with the textbooks that are returned.
 - c. The dates of the drop offs are determined by the first initial of the child's last name. This will ensure that siblings drop their work/textbooks off on the same day to eliminate having to come on multiple days.
