Registration packets containing the bank loan application and parishioner verification form for the 2020-2021 school year will be going home today with the oldest child in the family. Please return completed forms to the school by Friday, 2/14/20. The registration fee of \$225.00 per student is also due by Friday, 2/14/20. You will receive an email today with an online registration form to be updated. There will be an option to pay your registration fee by credit card, debit card or eCheck along with this email. A link to pay the remaining fees (tuition, supply fee, etc.) will be added to the Parent Portal later this week. Tuition and other fees are due by May 15, 2020 if you are prepaying. It is important that you get your registration and registration fees in by 2/14/20 as after this date we will be having registration with Maria Immacolata students and open registration students.
