Sunday, October 15

- **Senior Father/Son Gathering**
 - A senior mom of a boy is normally in charge of this.
- **Tea for the court girls and their moms**
 - **2:00-4:00**
 - Girls on the Homecoming Court and their moms will participate in a tea at Madewood Plantation.

Monday, October 16

- **Class Color Dress Day**
 - Designing/Purchasing a class shirt is **OPTIONAL**; the only criteria for this day is wearing the color assigned to your class.
 - Seniors – Black
 - Juniors – Blue
 - Sophomores – Yellow
 - Freshmen – Purple
 - 8th Graders – Orange
 - 7th Graders – Green
 - Teachers/Staff – Faculty Shirt
- **Junior High Volleyball Game**
 - Home game against Chitimacha 5:00
- **Wacky Olympics 7:00 (on the CCHS football field or the old gym if it rains)**
 - Students will participate with their class in different Wacky Olympics Events.
 - Students will sign up with their class moderators for these events; give everyone a chance to sign up before signing up for more than one event.
 - Parents/Community are welcome to attend as spectators.

Tuesday, October 17

 - **ALL DECORATIONS MUST DISPLAY SCHOOL SPIRIT AND NOT MENTION THE HOMECOMING THEME NOR THE SPECIFIC CLASS. WE PLAY HANSON SO YOU CAN PUT THINGS RELATED TO BEATING HANSON TIGERS.**

 - Clean up will take place by all participants immediately following the gym decorating.

Thursday, October 19

- **Mass Dress Day**
 - All students will wear their mass uniform.
 - The Homecoming Court will be presented during the mass; Court Members and Escorts will wear clothing appropriate for church; See **Mrs. Rhodes** for more information.
- **Mass** begins at **9:00** am.
- **Parade**
 - Parade will begin at **5:30** in front of the school on **Franklin Street**.
 - Spirit Groups may walk in the parade representing their group.
 - The football team will walk as a team in the parade
 - There will be a flatbed for the 7th and 8th graders.
 - There will be a flatbed for the 9th, 10th, 11th, and 12th graders.
 - There will be a flatbed for the female court members.
 - Each flatbed can provide their own appropriate music and decorations.
 - **NO THROWS!!!!!!!!!!**

- **Red Bean Dinner**
 - Doors will open at **6:00** for the opening prayer.
 - Beans will be served.
 - Juniors are responsible providing sweets and drinks for the bean dinner. Get with your class officers and moderators for more information.
 - Clean up by all participants will immediately follow the bean dinner.
- **Pep Rally** (This is THE Homecoming Pep Rally)
 - The Pep Rally will be in the **new** gym; it will start approximately at **7:15**.

Friday, October 20

- **Spirit Dress Day**

 - These shirts will be on sale **Monday, October 9 – Friday, October 13**

- **Football Game and Homecoming Court**
 - CCHS vs Hanson at **7:00 pm**.
 - Homecoming Court Presentation will begin at **6:15**.
 - The Queen will be announced during halftime. If it is raining, the Queen will be announced after the game in the new gym.
 - The Freshman Class is responsible for decorating and the cleaning up of the stadium for the game; you can use the decorations from the gym; get with your class officers and moderators for more information.
 - The Sophomore class is responsible for setting up and the tearing down/cleaning up of the homecoming court platform and chairs; get with your class officers and moderators for more information. The tearing down of the platform and chairs will have to take place after the game on Friday.

Saturday, October 21

- **Homecoming Dance**
 - This is for students in grades 9-12 ONLY; Junior High students do not attend this event.

- Students bringing a date from another school will need to turn in their date's name to Deacon Vic by **Wednesday, October 18**.
- This event takes place in the old gym.
- The Seniors are responsible for decorating and cleaning up for the Homecoming Dance.
- Court Presentation and King Announcement begins at **8:00**.
- Dance is from **9:00-11:30** (Students **MUST** be in the doors by **9:00**).
- Tickets can be purchased during recess in the mall beginning **Monday, October 16**; tickets are \$15 for a single and \$20 for a couple. Tickets cannot be purchased at the door.
- Deadline for purchasing tickets is **Wednesday, October 18**.

Helpful Hints For A Successful Homecoming Week

- **Be Smart and Safe**
 - Think before you participate in activities that could cause harm and/or damage to others or their property.
- **Dress Appropriately**
 - Shorts must be of decent length (two inches above the knee)
 - No tights or spandex unless under an appropriate length tutu

Homecoming Dance Dress Guidelines

 - **Check the length with the heels being worn**
- **The way the dress fits the individual is also very important. Certain styles are made for certain figures.**
