Book Fair At-a-Glance

In celebration of our Fall Book Fair (**November 12th – November 16th**), several contests, raffles and activities will take place. Our Book Fair theme is *Enchanted Forest Book Fair – Let Your Imagination Grow!*

Monday – Friday (November 12 – November 16):

Students can take a chance to win books, posters or supplies that are on display at the Book Fair by participating in the “lollipop pull”. The cost is a quarter (25¢) per pull. Students are eligible to win a prize if the end of the lollipop stick is painted. Students can also participate in the “pencil pull”. The cost is fifty cents (50¢) per pull. Students who pull a sharpened pencil win a prize. The money collected in these contests will go toward our **All for Books** campaign. In addition, you may also donate loose change. A collection jar will be set up in the library.

Students in grades 1-4 will be entered in a coloring contest. Students in grades 5-7 will be entered in an art contest based on the Book Fair theme. Grades 5-7 will make a Book Fair flyer which can be hand-drawn or computer generated. All PK3, PK4 and Kindergarten students can participate in a special “Guessing Game.”

Visitors to our Book Fair may want to stop by the **Classroom Wish List** display where teachers have selected books they would love to add to their classroom libraries.

Monday 11/12: 4-H Club officers will give a book talk during morning announcements. We will kick off our “Scholastic 20 for 20 Family Reading Challenge” where families are encouraged to read for 20 minutes a day over 20 school days.

Tuesday 11/13: Students may wear pajamas for “Pajamarama Tuesday”.

Wednesday 11/14: Dress as your favorite fairytale character on “Make-believe Wednesday”. Families who have sent in their **RSVP** may join us for our **Family Reading Night** from 6:00 p.m. – 7:30 p.m.

Thursday 11/15: “Get Caught Reading Day” – Students who are caught reading will receive a ticket to “Guess How Much Unicorn Food”. The student with the correct guess (closest number without going over) will win a prize.

Friday 11/16: Students may visit the Book Fair with their Grandparents for Grandparent’s Day!
