In first and second grades, a student will repeat the grade if he/she fails language arts (F), Mathematics (F), or reading (D or F). A student earning a D or F in reading for the last nine weeks may be referred to the administration for promotion or retention. Parents will be notified by the teacher, and a meeting with the principal and the teacher will be arranged to discuss the need for retention.
In third through seventh grades, a student will repeat the grade if he/she fails two or more major subjects or one major subject and two or more minor subjects. The major subjects are reading, math, social studies, science and language.
