MAKE SPECIAL NOTE:

1. Our Book Fair begins Monday in the Family Center. The schedule for class visits was sent home this past week. Parents may visit the Book Fair during recesses and anytime during the bazaar. Family Night is Tuesday from 3:30 to 6 PM.
2. The Halloween Bazaar is Wednesday, October 31st. Here are the particulars:
 - The bazaar begins at 12:30 and ends at 2:30 PM
 - It is a fun dress day, but costumes are **NOT** allowed.
 - Set up begins at 10:30 AM. Lots of help is needed to have everything ready for the bazaar to begin on time.
 - Volunteers are also needed for cleanup.

- Parents may donate **individually wrapped homemade treats that do not contain nuts and can be sent the morning of the bazaar.**

 - Visitors must sign in at the front office and receive a visitor's pass.
 - Pre-K, YK and Kindergarten students must have a parent or guardian with them during the bazaar.
 - Students should be signed out in their classrooms if parents want to leave early with them. This does not affect perfect attendance.
 - Students do not need money for the bazaar. The event is paid for through home and school dues.
 - Decorated pumpkins are due in the Family Center between 8 and 8:30 AM on Monday, October 29th. Pumpkins should not have student's names on them, nor should they be carved or punctured with dowels or toothpicks. Pumpkins will be on display in the Family Center and should be picked up by the end of the day on Wednesday, October 31st.
 - Share Shop will be set up in the Family Center beginning Monday. Please help yourself to uniform parts.
3. We are celebrating All Saints Day on Thursday, November 1st. Students are encouraged to dress as their favorite Saint. Many of our students have honored this tradition from kindergarten through seventh grade. There will be no school mass on Friday.
 4. Winners of the Halloween art and pumpkin contests may wear their spirit shirts on Tuesday, November 6th.
 5. We will continue to collect items for the hurricane victims in Florida.
