- **IMPORTANT TUITION/LOAN INFORMATION**
 - Pre-paid school tuition is due by **Friday, May 14, 2021**. There will be a **\$100 per family LATE FEE** if tuition and fees are received after 5/21/21. There will be a **\$150 per family LATE FEE** if tuition and fees are received after 5/28/21.
 - If you need to **renew your tuition loan or open a new loan for 2021-2022**, please make sure you complete the Synergy **loan application before 5/12/21**. This will ensure that the loan term will be 11 months beginning 6/15/21 and ending 4/15/22. Submit completed loan application to the school for processing.
- Please note that students will still be able to dress down every Wednesday until the end of the school year for their \$1 donations for Teacher's Appreciation Week. They will be allowed to wear a school appropriate T-shirt, jeans and tennis shoes. **Students in PK and kindergarten may wear shorts.**
