DID YOU KNOW ...

... Now that the Governor's stay-at-home order has been extended until the end of the school year, we will continue with distance learning for the remainder of the year.

...that the deadline for pre-paid tuition for 2020-2021 has been extended to June 15, 2020 to give families more time.

...that the before and after bell payments for March will include March 1-13. There will be no charge for the remainder of the school year. You will receive a reimbursement if you already paid for that time.

MAKE SPECIAL NOTE:

1. The faculty is meeting on Tuesday to discuss the end of the year events. More information will be available in next week's newsletter.
2. Due to the current situation, we have decided to extend the tuition assistance program until May 1, 2020. If you are interested, please email Mrs. Cheryl Thibodaux at cheryl.thibodaux@hdiocese.org to obtain a tuition assistance packet.
3. Tuition loans from Synergy Bank for this school year must be paid by May 1st. New loans for the next school year will not be processed unless this year's loan is paid in full.
4. For parents with Synergy Bank Loans: If you did not have a loan for the 2019-2020 school year, the person who signed the Synergy Bank Tuition Loan Data

Form must go to the Synergy Bank South Acadia Branch. We will inform you of the bank signing dates as soon as they are available. If you already have an established loan, your new loan will be automatically activated.

5. Anyone wanting a refund from the cafeteria must email Ms. Tiffany (stgenevieve@schoolcafe.org) to let her know before the end of the school year. Money left in an account will be rolled over for students who are returning next year. If your child has a negative cafeteria balance, please take care of this matter.
