## **SPIRITUAL:**

- **CCES Masses: Wednesdays at 8:00 am:** Individual grade levels (Grades 2-5) lead Mass each week.
- **CCHS Masses: Fridays at 9:00 am**
- **CCHS Rosary: Thursdays at 7:15 am**
  - Please check our monthly calendar for Mass dates.
  - Parents and/or grandparents are welcomed and encouraged to celebrate with the students.
- **Holy Cross Church: Feast of the Holy Cross** - September 15 begins with 10:30 am Mass and includes a procession on Church grounds, Veneration of the Cross, lunch and fun activities for the children.
- **Know Someone Who Wants to Be a Catholic?** Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults (RCIA) is for anyone who has ever thought about joining the Catholic Church. If you are a baptized Catholic who has never celebrated First Eucharist or Confirmation, or if your spouse is Catholic and you would like to share in his/her faith experience, you are invited to a special program with other people like yourself where your questions will be answered. ## **DEVELOPMENT:**

- **ANNUAL FUND DRIVE:**
  - **CCES:** Families participating by August 30 will receive free jean day passes for their child(ren). Each class that reaches 100% participation will receive a special class treat.
  - **CCHS:** Families participating by September 28 will receive a free jean day for their child(ren).

## **CCES ADMINISTRATIVE REMINDERS:**

- **Birthday Day:** Student/teacher birthdays are celebrated on a designated Friday once a month. Summer months are included. Birthday students receive special recognition. On that day, **all** students may wear:
  - Plain, long blue denim knee-length walking shorts, capris, or jeans-no colored, striped, decorated jeans/no jean skirts or overalls
  - Regulation school shorts or long pants
  - Choice of CC t-shirt- (may be purchased through the office) or spirit shirt/sweatshirt
  - Choice of tennis shoes & socks-no heelliesDo not send class treats to school in celebration of individual birthdays without the **teacher's permission**. Gum, peanuts, and peanut butter are NOT allowed. Do not send balloons, flowers, etc. to school to an individual child. Birthday or other invitations may not be distributed at school unless the entire class or all girls or all boys are invited.
- **PTO:** The purpose of the PTO is to promote Central Catholic Elementary School. The primary responsibility of this group, comprised of parents and school personnel, is the promotion of Central Catholic Elementary School through community building activities and fundraising. Tiffany Cornes is President of this group. **Please join in and help promote our school among people in our community!**
- **Monday, September 2:** Labor Day - No school for students
- **Arrival and Dismissal Procedures:** The safety of the children is our focus. When you fail to comply, you

put their safety in jeopardy. Please follow our guidelines. Please avoid blocking the CCHS parking lot and the 4-way stop signs on Maple Street. Please be mindful of the direction you should travel through the parking lot. Only enter the parking lot from Franklin St. and exit the parking lot on Cedar.

- **Early Dismissal:** If a student must leave during the school day, a note must be sent to the teacher in advance, informing her of the time. **Students leaving school without advance notice are ineligible for assignments before checking out.**
- **CCES Cafeteria:** Lunch Money MUST be paid in advance. The cafeteria's computerized accounting system monitors each child's balance. Any amount may be paid to cover weekly or monthly amounts or beyond. If instructions are needed for online payments, please contact Charmaine Singleton, Cafeteria Manager, 384-1487. This program is funded partially by our federal Government, and in order for it to work efficiently, the school must stay in good standing financially.
- **Holiday Treats and Gifts:** Holiday and special treats may not be sent to school unless approved by the teacher. Approved treats must be brought to the office, NOT the classroom. Gum, peanuts, and peanut butter are NOT allowed.
- **Handbook Sign-off Sheet:** Please print online, sign and return if you have not already done so.

- **Immunization Letter:** Sent out to parents. Check your child's school bag and return information.
- **Change of Address:** If you have an address, phone number or email change, please let us know.
