

3rd Grade Summer Reading Project

****Due Date: Monday, August 5th** (You may turn in on Friday, Aug. 2nd for book day.)**

Welcome to 3rd grade! This year will be full of new adventures. In fact, our journey starts this summer! Over the summer you will participate in the Scholastic Summer Reading Program. This will be counted as a major grade in Reading. It is very important that you complete the required reading activities **BEFORE** the first day of school. **Requirements:**

- ❖ Read **at least THREE** books at your reading level.
- ❖ Read and Log a *minimum* of 500 minutes on your Reading Log **AND ONLINE!** (include title & minutes on log)
 - ◆ www.scholastic.com/summer
 - ◆ **Note: You will not get credit if you don't do both! (Written log and online)**
- ❖ Complete a **Critic's Corner** work sheet for each book read. (You must have at least 3.)
 - ◆ This must be in complete sentences, legible, and detailed to get full credit.
- ❖ Complete a comic strip on **ONE** of your books read! You must select a book from your Critic's Corner worksheets.

➤ Create a comic strip

- On a **half size** poster board (5 pts.)
- First scene must include title, author, and illustrator (5 pts.)
- Must show a clear beginning, middle, and end (plot) (5 pts.)
- At least 5 illustrated scenes using speech bubbles to show dialogue (5 pts.)
- Include a caption below each scene describing the scene (5 pts.)
- Be creative, neat, and make sure you include color!!! (5 pts.)



Your project **and completed packet** will be turned in on **Monday, August 5th** for a Reading grade. Your packet should include the following:

- (1 pts) **Pledge** (beige sheet)
- (4 pts) **Reading Log**—with minutes/title of books logged in **AND YOU MUST LOG IN MINUTES AT www.scholastic.com/summer** (You will not get credit if you don't do both logins correctly.)
- (15 pts) Complete 3 **Critic's Corner worksheets** for each book read, including a *minimum* of 3 sentences for every response on the worksheet.
- (30 pts) Complete comic book strip on **ONE** of your books read.

Total Points: 50 ***Note: You will have 5 points off for everyday late!***

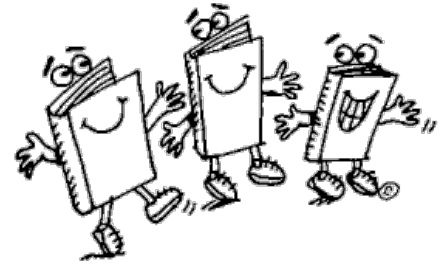
