October 7 is the feast of Our Lady of the Rosary.

Pray the rosary together as a family this week. If you can, pray a whole rosary every day. If that's too much, try this:

Sunday: Apostles Creed, Our Father, 3 Hail Marys, Glory Be (the "first part" of the rosary)

Monday: First mystery of your choice and the first decade

Tuesday: Second mystery of your choice and the second decade

Wednesday: Third mystery of your choice and the third decade

Thursday: Fourth mystery of your choice and the fourth decade

Friday: Fifth mystery of your choice and the fifth decade

Saturday: Hail Holy Queen and the closing prayer:

"O God, whose only begotten Son, by His life, death, and resurrection, has purchased for us the rewards of eternal life, grant, we beseech Thee, that while meditating upon these mysteries of the Most Holy Rosary of the Blessed Virgin Mary, that we may imitate what they contain and obtain what they promise, through the same Christ Our Lord. Amen."
